URINE SAMPLE COLLECTION FOR MTDNA VARIANT CARRIER TESTING (TEST CODE T822 ONLY)

Before you Begin:

 Ensure you have the correct collection container requirements: Sterile, preservative-free, screw top lid, minimum 30 mL volume.

Collecting your Sample:

Note: First morning urine is the preferred specimen for this test, although random urine samples are also accepted.

- 2. Remove the lid from the sterile urine cup.
- 3. Collect at least 30 mL of urine into the sterile urine cup.
- Place the lid back on the urine cup and close tightly. Please ensure the cap is screwed on evenly and completely to avoid any leaking.
- 5. Fill out the provided label with name and date of birth of the patient. Place the label on the side of the urine cup (only one label is sufficient).
- Package according to Category B shipment guidelines including leak-proof secondary packaging. Ship at ambient temperature for overnight delivery with arrival Monday-Saturday. Specimens can be refrigerated for 7 days before shipping. DO NOT FREEZE.

*Note for pediatric patients: samples collected with urine collection bags are accepted if they are transferred to a sterile, screw top urine container prior to shipment.

The sample will be rejected if the sample is contaminated with another substance (blood, stool, etc.).
